To the Ontario Provincial Legislature:



Because the minimum wage was frozen at \$6.85 for almost 9 years despite significant increases in the cost of living; and

Because the McGuinty Liberals have raised it by a mere 30 cents and \$7.15 is still far too low, and

Because a full-time worker earning the current minimum wage in a large city is almost \$6000 below the poverty line, and to reach the poverty line would need an hourly wage of at least \$10*; and

Because the minimum wage should provide people with an adequate standard of living;

We demand that the Ontario government immediately increase the minimum wage to at least the poverty line – that means \$10 an hour and index it to the cost of living.
