

Stop Creating Homelessness and Hunger! Petition

Incomes of the Poor Should Reflect the Cost of Living PETITION

Whereas the Government of Ontario reduced social assistance rates paid to low-income households by 21.6% in 1995, then froze them at that level.

Whereas the Government of Ontario stopped all funding for affordable public housing in 1995, then eliminated rent controls in 1998.

Whereas the cost of housing in Ontario has increased by 24% in the past seven years, well above the rate of inflation for that period, while the shelter allowance, the portion of the social assistance cheque that is to be used to pay for housing costs, has remained stagnant.

Whereas in Toronto, for example, the average rent for a two bedroom apartment costs \$1,047 per month and the shelter allowance for a single parent with two kids receiving welfare is just \$554 per month.

Whereas skyrocketing rents and stagnant incomes place incredible financial stress on low-income households.

Whereas low-income households are forced to use money for food and other basic necessities to keep a roof over their heads, causing them to go without many basic needs, like food, clothing and medications.

Therefore be it resolved that we, the undersigned, petition the Legislative Assembly of Ontario to demand that the Provincial Government of Ontario provide shelter allowances that reflect the actual cost of housing across the province.
